His expertise encompasses geospatial data processing and standardization for multi-country programs, enterprise GIS infrastructure management, spatial analysis and visualization, forest inventory and monitoring systems, and precision agriculture applications. With a strong background in both forestry engineering and geospatial information sciences, he excels in leveraging Python automation, machine learning techniques, and advanced remote sensing to solve complex spatial problems. Mr. Medina processes and validates GPS datasets for surveys across multiple countries, ensuring compliance with spatial data protocols. He produces high-quality thematic maps and spatial visualizations for final survey reports, presentations, and technical briefings. His responsibilities include conducting rigorous quality control checks on geospatial data prior to publication and release. Mr. Medina develops training materials and co-facilitates the Health Data Mapping workshop to strengthen geospatial capacity-building for international staff. He leads multilateral meetings with international colleagues in English, French, and Portuguese, and performs literature reviews and spatial analysis for public health and environmental research initiatives. operations and creates automation scripts with Python and Microsoft PowerShell to optimize workflows.

Mr. Medina ensured data quality for city-wide analytical tools including the Crash Data Hub built with ArcGIS Experience Builder.
